The mechanical engineering students were keen in observing the presentation and many of them interacted with the speaker. More particular they asked the support services for the rural youth.



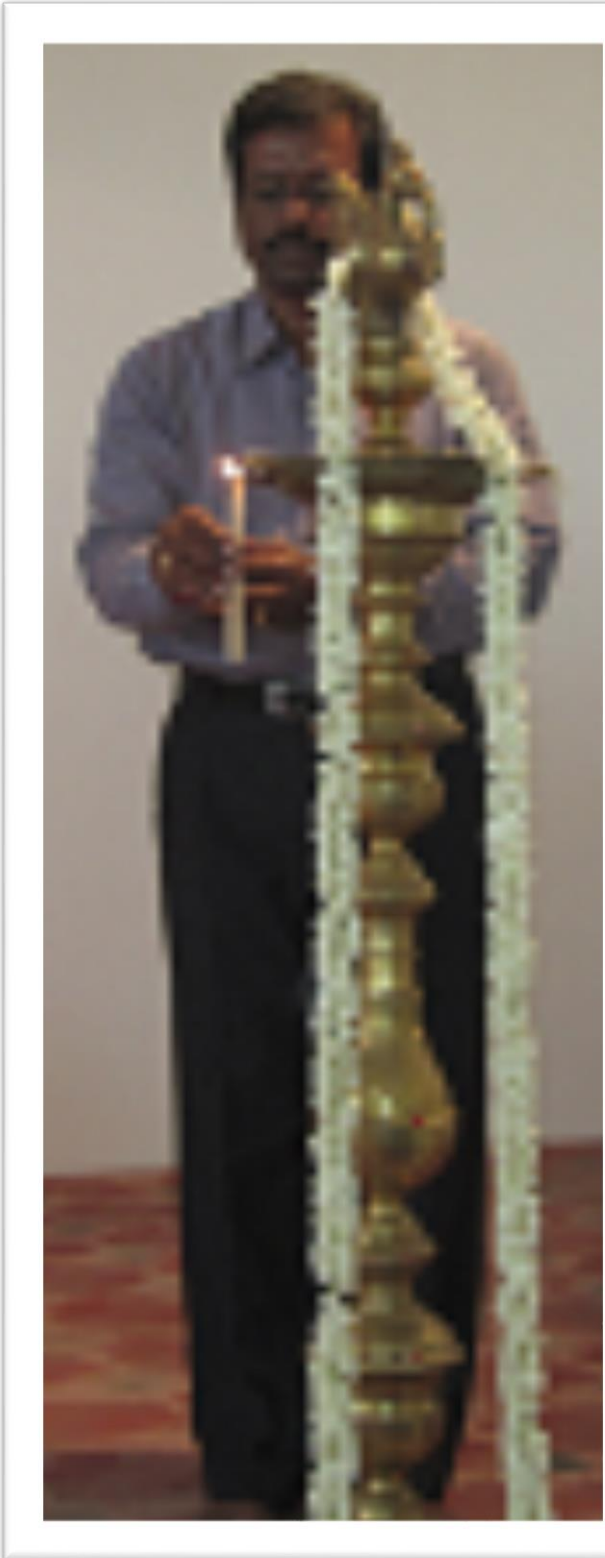
